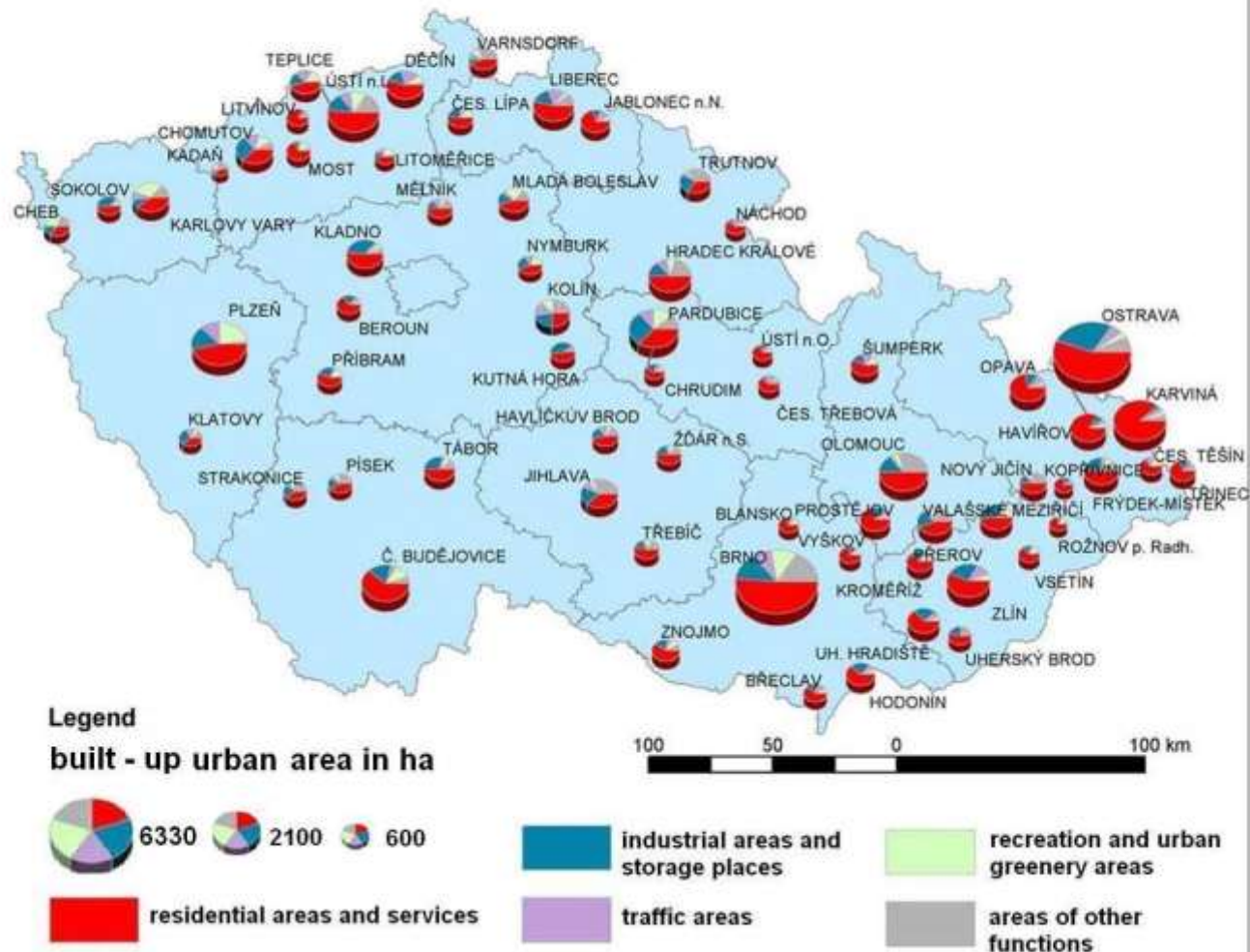

Division of the town into core area and associated area

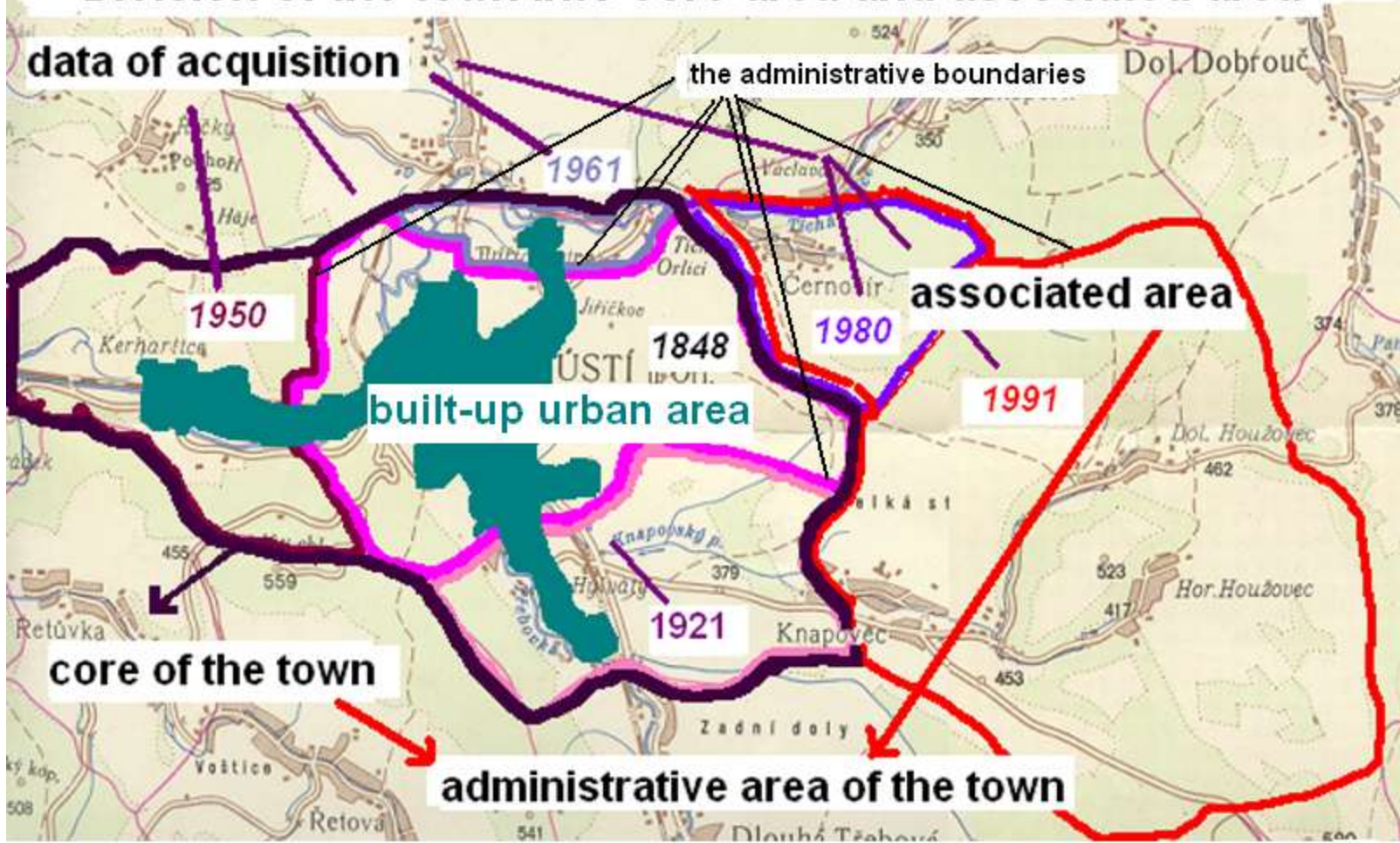

ADMINISTRATIVE AREAS AND CORE AREAS OF CZECH TOWNS IN THE YEAR 1990

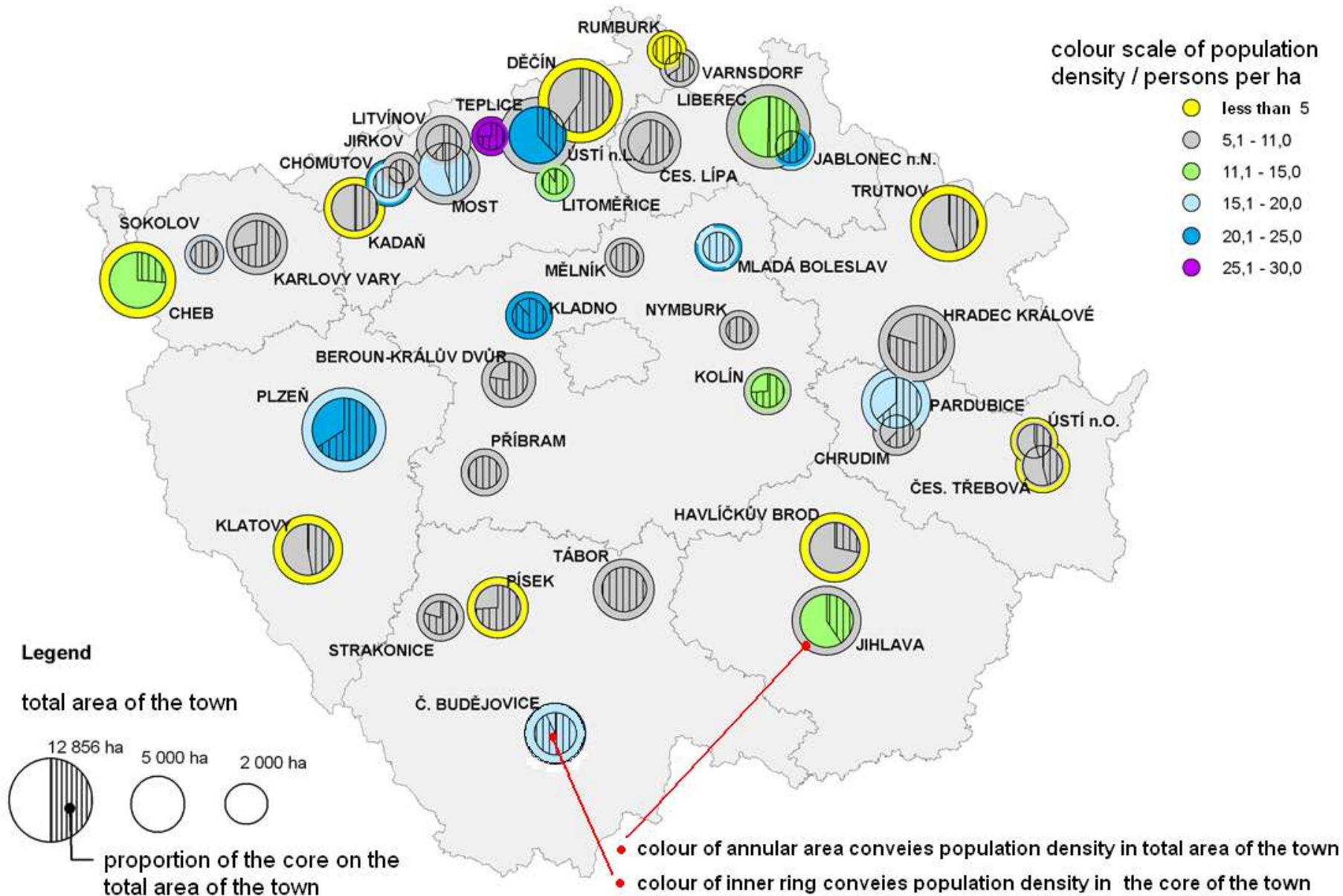

The growth of urban areas and urban population of Czech towns

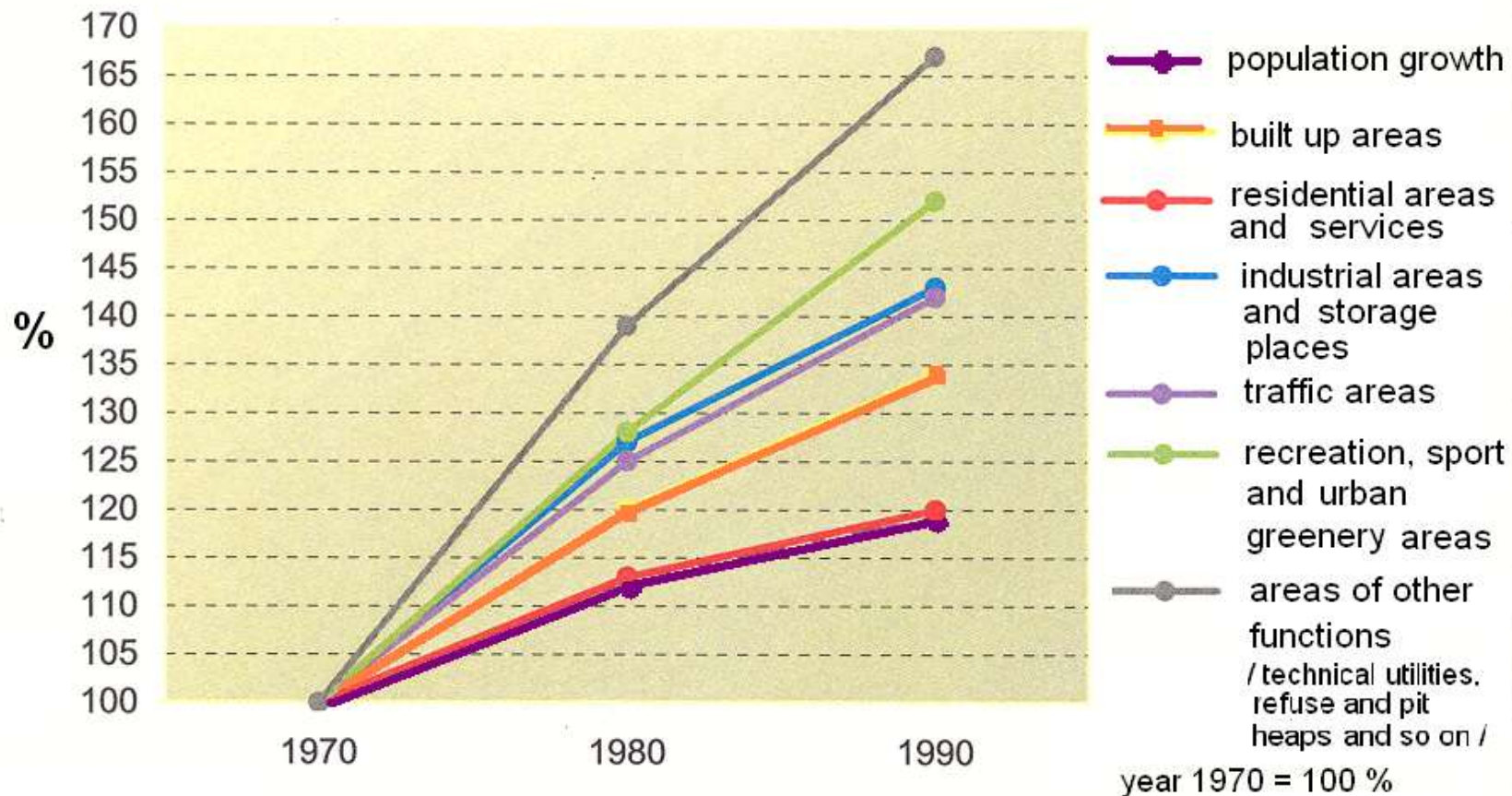
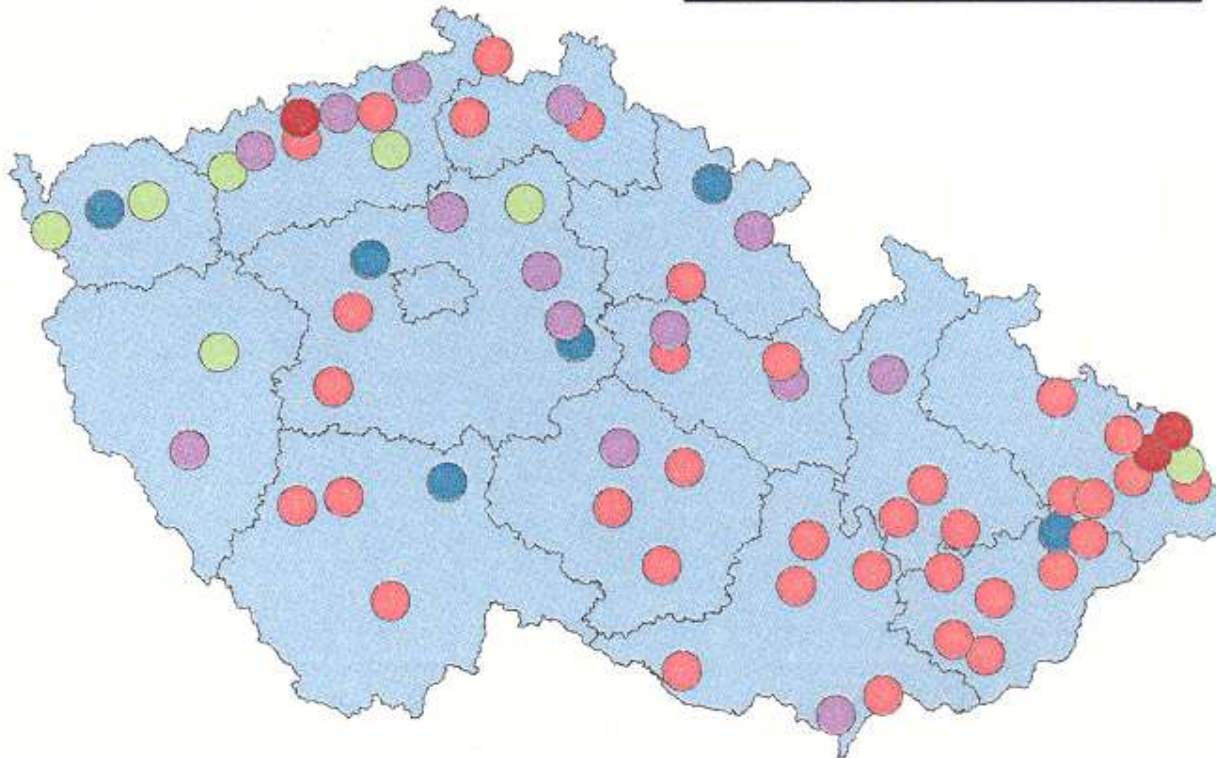

Typology of the towns by share of the functional areas in built - up urban areas in the year 1990

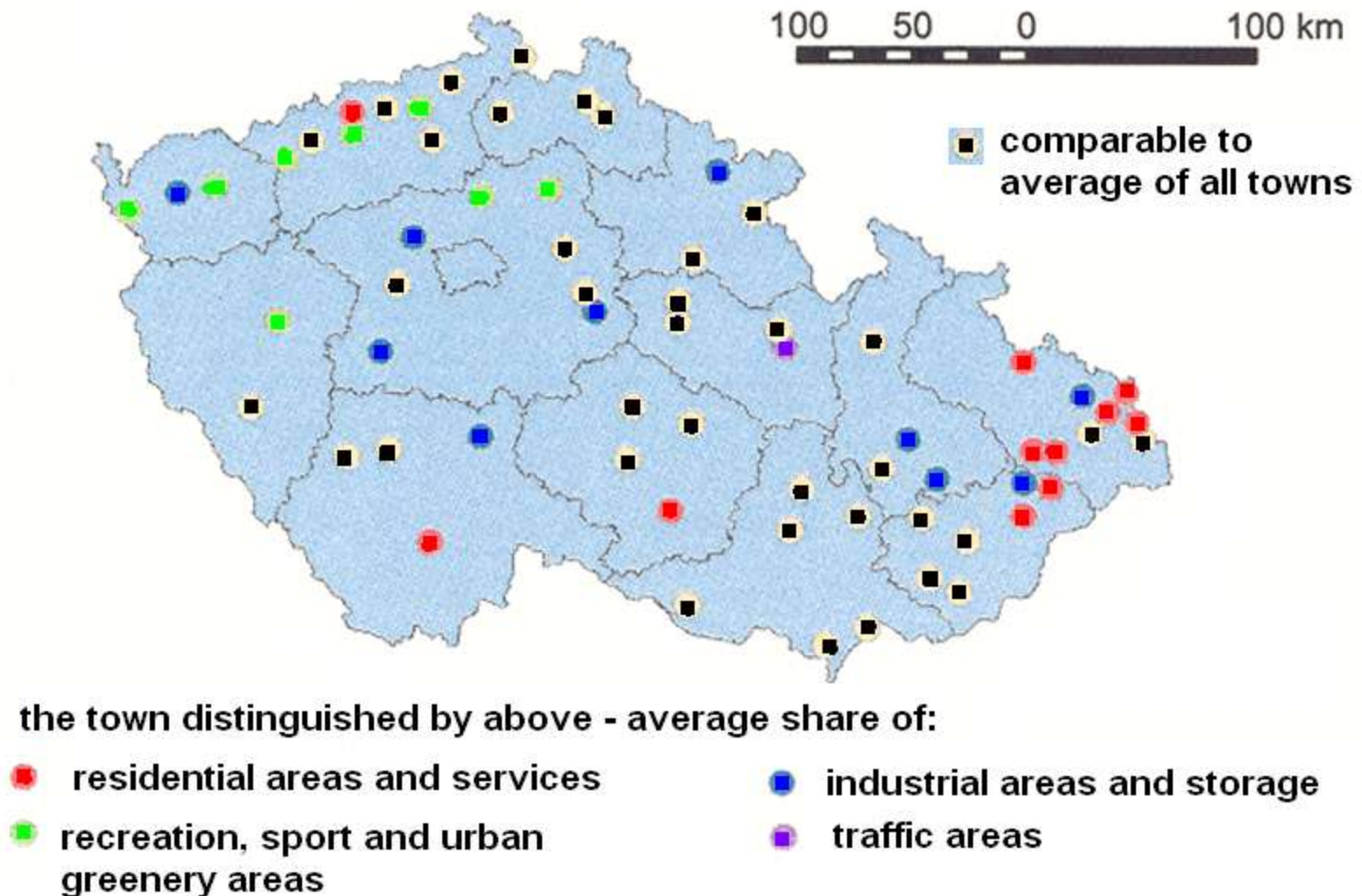
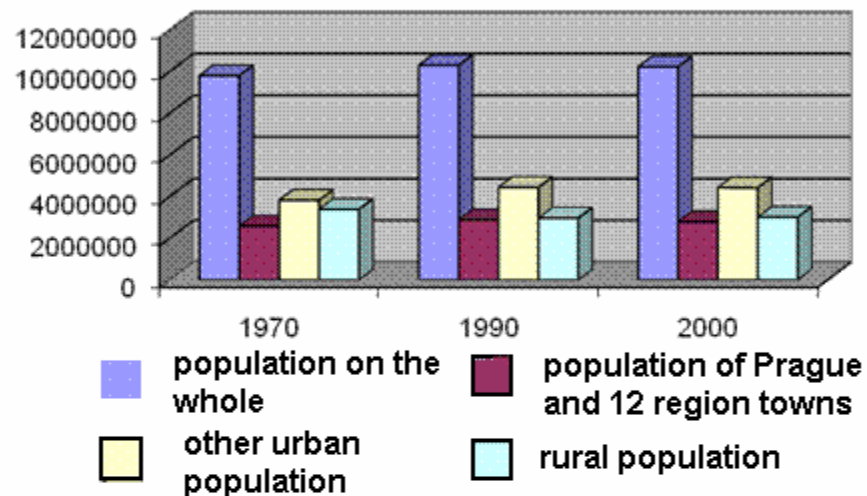

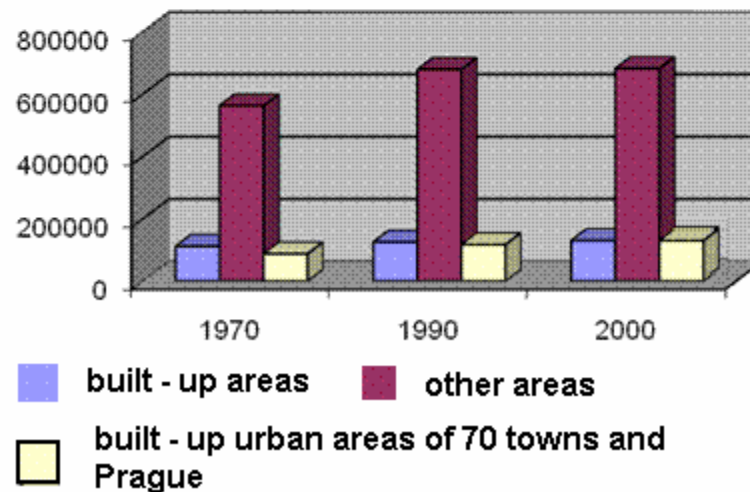
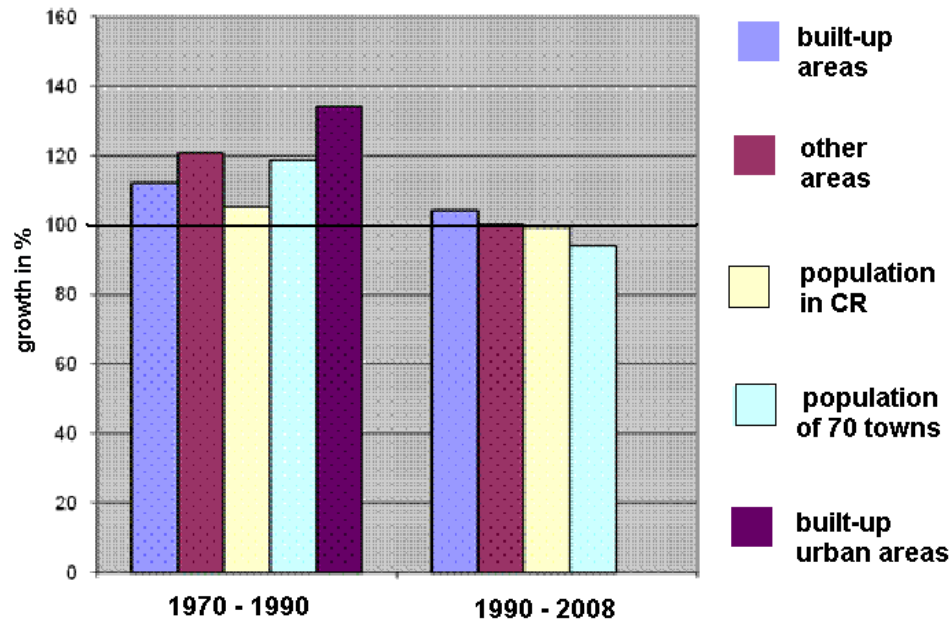

Land Use in ha

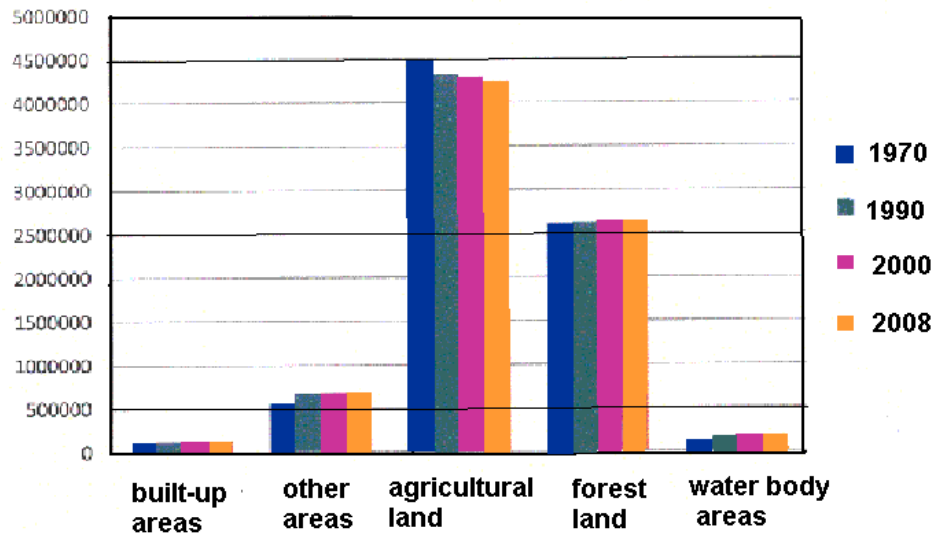
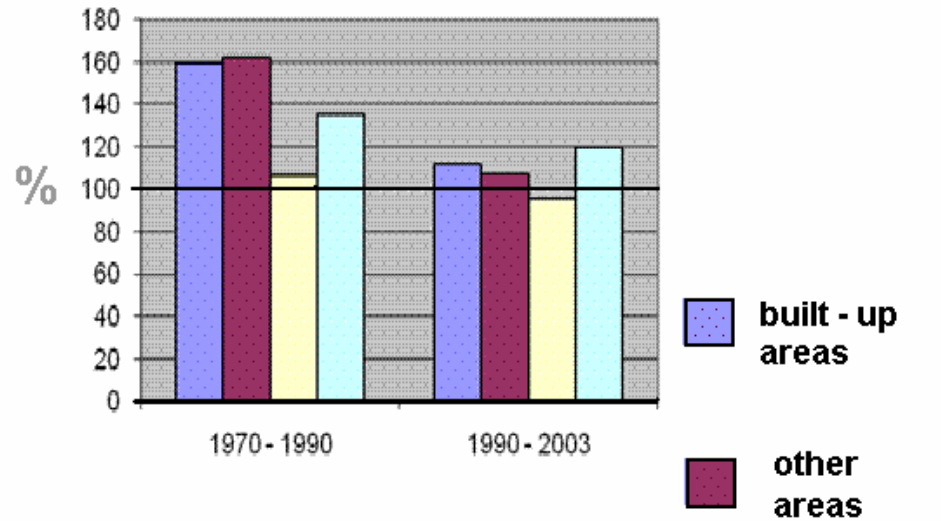

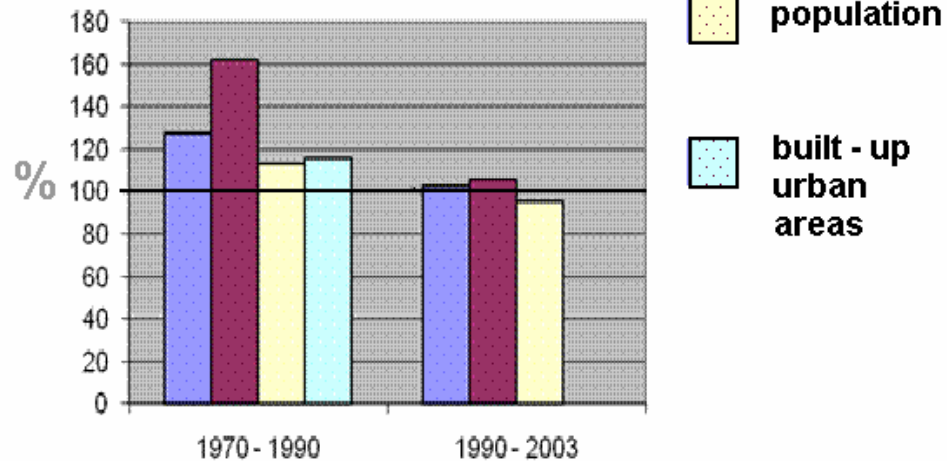
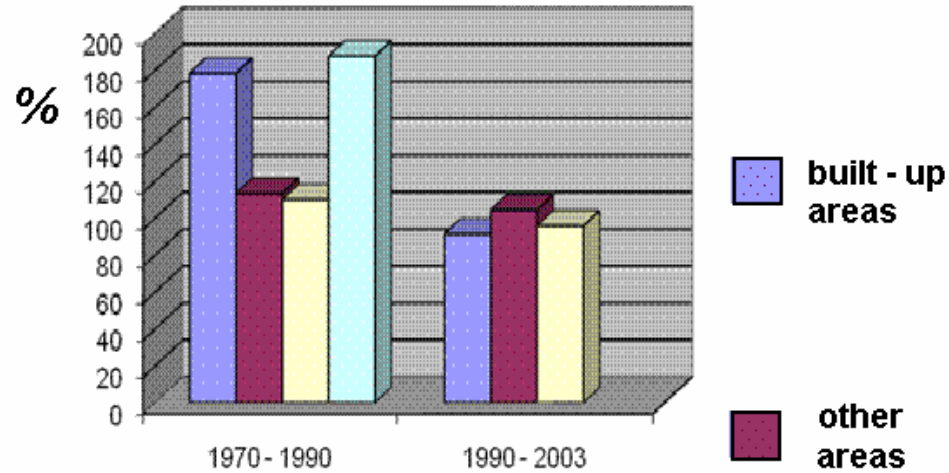

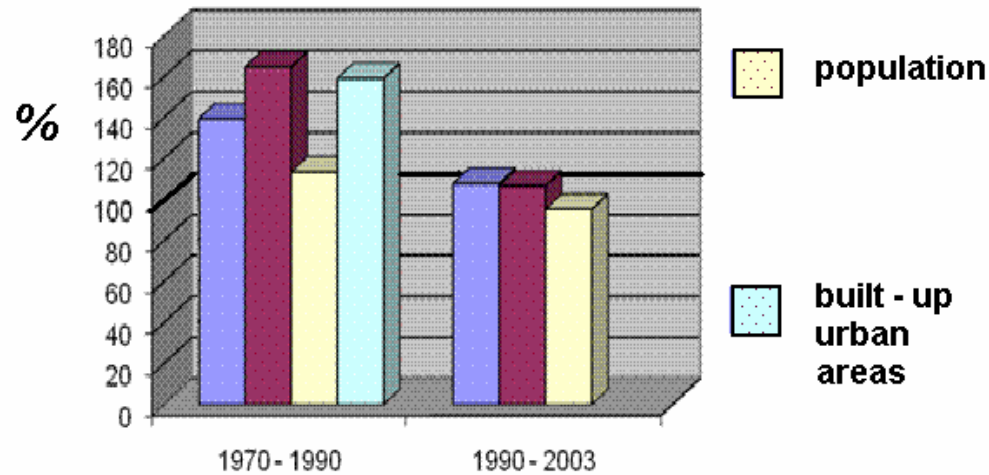
